The 2010 summer cruise is right around the corner. It will take place from July 3rd to July 11th. Registration is now open on the BYC website. We'll be returning to the cape and islands with ports of call at Cuttyhunk, Vineyard Haven, Cataumet, and Padanaram. We hope you will join us for, what is sure to be, a great time. Our planned itinerary is:

- Saturday, July 3rd: Cuttyhunk: Some members of the fleet will be departing early in order to help secure moorings for later arrivals.
- Sunday, July 4th: Lay day in Cuttyhunk. 4th of July Parade
- Monday, July 5th: Lake Tashmoo, Martha's Vineyard. Anchor in marked anchorage.
- Tuesday, July 6th: Vineyard Haven Harbor. Moorings have been reserved. Contact harbormaster upon arrival.
- Wednesday, July 7th: Lay day in Vineyard Haven. Activities on your own.
- Thursday, July 8th: Redbrook Harbor, Cataumet. Kingman Marine. Contact Kingman Marine for a slip or mooring. Cruise Dinner at The Chart Room Restaurant
- Friday, July 9th: Lay day in Redbrook Harbor, Cataumet. Activities on your own.
- Saturday, July 10th: Padanaram Harbor, South Dartmouth. Contact South Warf Marina for slip space.
- Sunday, July 11th: Fleet Returns to BYC

You should begin to make your reservations. For slip or mooring space in Redbrook Harbor, contact Kingman Marina at 508-563-7136. Let them know you are with the Barrington Yacht Club cruise. Slips are \$3.50/ft per night and moorings are \$50 per day. Reservations are fully refundable less a \$20 fee if cancelled 7 days in advance.

You can also contact South Warf Marina in Padanaram at 508-990-1011 and ask for the Dock Master to arrange for slip space. Slips are \$1.70/ft plus \$15 per night if you would like electric. Be sure to let them know you are with the Barrington Yacht Club as we have negotiated a discounted rate.

Launch drivers will be wearing light blue shirts and will be responsible for providing both launch and marina service. House and Dock stewards will again be wearing navy blue shirts and will be responsible for the clubhouse, Dana Rice, and fuel dock. Bartenders, Office, and Management will be assigned white shirts. Most of the staff from last year will be returning and will be easily recognized.

### **Sailing Dinghy Storage Policy**

1. All sailing dinghies (Sunfish, Laser, 420, etc) stored on BYC property on either the racks or dollies must be labeled with appropriate 2010 BYC sticker and registered with club management.
2. Summer storage applications are available online, under "Club Services & Hours" and then "Office Information" or can be obtained from Club Management during normal business hours.
3. Fees are listed on the fee schedule in the Log.
4. Storage on dollies is only available in the designated space east of the storage container north of the northeast corner of the parking lot.
5. May 1st is the deadline to start removing all dinghies stored over the winter at BYC.
6. Sailing Dinghies not removed by June 1st, will be considered abandoned property and may be removed from the club premise.

### **Grill Night Rules for Children**

- Please help us achieve a safe environment by having your children adhere to these simple guidelines
- No climbing on the anchor or flagpole, rock walls, dock ramps or under the clubhouse at anytime.
- Children are not allowed on the docks without their parents and must be wearing lifejackets.
- Children are not to play in the parking lot due to traffic or the sand lot due to work in progress.
- No throwing of objects in the tent, boat ramp, parking lot or anywhere else on the BYC grounds.
- No children are allowed outside the club after sunset without being accompanied by their parents.
