Let us pray for the friends and family of those lost in California and, as Michael Conrad as Sergeant Phil Esterhaus on Hill Street Blues used to say, "Let's be careful out there."

- Quorum of 5 members.

SAILING DINGHY STORAGE POLICY

1. All sailing dinghies (Sunfish, Laser, 420, Kayaks, etc) stored on BYC property on either the racks or dollies must be la-beled with appropriate 2012 BYC sticker and registered with club management.
2. Summer storage applications are available online, un-der "Club Services & Hours" and then "Office Information" or can be obtained from Club Management during normal business hours.
3. Fees are listed on the fee schedule earlier in the Log.
4. Storage on dollies is only available in the designated space east of the storage container north of the northeast corner of the parking lot.
5. May 1st is the deadline to start removing all dinghies stored over the winter at BYC.
6. Sailing Dinghies not removed by June 1st, will be considered abandoned property and may be removed from the club premise.
