Notice of Race

Amendment #1

The Notice of Race is hereby amended for the sole use of the Corinthian Class as follows:

REGISTRATION AND ELIGIBILITY

Change the third sentence to read:

“...One of the potential classes maybe a class for those sailors who want to sail on Tuesday evenings, but do not have either the experience or desire for more competitive or high-intensity racing; *this would be called the Corinthian Class (see differences for Corinthian Class below)*”...

Add the following after Registration and before fees:

“CORINTHIAN CLASS:

- 1) If a sufficient number of boats, as judged by the race committee, enter and state their intention to race in this class by the Registration Deadline (5/13/10), this class will be formed. To enter a completed application, waiver and fee must be received by the Registration deadline.
- 2) The Corinthian Class will only exist for Series 2 (July 13- August 31).
- 3) Entry fees will be the same as for any boat participating in only one of the series, as described below, under Fees.
- 4) A current PHRF certificate will not be required in this class; instead, a rating will be given to each boat without a current certificate by Steve Thurston, the BYC fleet measurer, at no charge.
- 5) It is the intent of the Race Committee that the Corinthian Class will be the last class to start each night.
- 6) Awards will be given each night after racing, as described below, under awards.
- 7) The series will be scored as follows:
For the Corinthian Class, if all scheduled races or 1 less (7 or 8) are sailed in the series, then the worst three scores shall be excluded. If 2 or 3 less (5 or 6) are sailed, then the worst two scores shall be excluded.
