Notice of Race

BYC CENTENNIAL REGATTA 1908-2008

July 19-20, 2008

1 Rules

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).
- 1.2 The Organizing Authority is Barrington Yacht Club
- 1.3 Sailing Instructions will be available no later than July 10, 2008 at the Barrington Yacht Club, Posted at the Official Notice Board and on the Barrington Yacht Club web site.
- 1.4 All amendments to the Sailing Instructions and the Notice of Race will be posted on the Official Notice Board at the Barrington Yacht Club
- 1.5 This regatta is a qualifying event for NBYA Boat of the Year
- 1.6 This regatta is the Laser Class District 7 Championship.
- 1.7 The PHRF-NB certificate is required for PHRF Boats.
- 1.8 Advertising shall be allowed per ISAF regulation 20; Category C for Olympic classes and Category A for all other classes.

2 Eligibility:

- 2.1 The regatta is open to any boat in the following classes:
 - Circle A;
 - PHRF (spinnaker and non-spinnaker), splits, if any, will be at the discretion of the race committee.
 - J-35, J-30, each racing as a one design class.
 - Circle B - One design.
 - J-24, S-boats, Pearson 26, Sea Sprite, Rhodes 19
 - Circle C - singlehanded dinghy.
 - Laser, Laser Radial, Sunfish
- 2.2 There must be five or more boats entered in each class for a class to be started and scored.
- 2.3 The organizing authority reserves the right to add classes with a minimum of five entries.

3. Entries

- 3.1 Entries shall be submitted on the official entry form, including the attached Waiver.
- 3.2 Classes shall meet the minimum entry requirements no later than July 10, 2008.
- 3.3 Registration fee is \$55, with late, after July 10, 2008, registration fee of \$70.
- 3.4 A \$5.00 credit will be given for US Sailing and/or Barrington Yacht club membership,
 - 3.4.1 only one credit will be given.
- 3.5 Registration by mail to the Barrington Yacht Club is preferred. In person registration can be made by bringing a completed application to the Barrington Yacht Club during normal business hours, and no later than 0830 on July 19, 2008.

4. Sailing areas.

- 4.1 Circle A will rendezvous in the area of Ohio Ledge bell.
- 4.2 Circle B will rendezvous South of Barrington Beach
- 4.3 Circle C will rendezvous off Bristol Highlands, North and East of the channel.
 - 4.3.1 Circle C boats will launch from Colt State Park.

5. Courses.

- 5.1 All courses will use drop marks.
- 5.2 Details of marks to be used will be in the Sailing Instructions.

6. Schedule of Races.

- 6.1 Five races are scheduled for Circles A and B
- 6.2 Circle C will sail as many races as possible.
- 6.3 First signal shall be at 1100 each day.
- 6.4 No warning signal will be made after 1500 on Sunday, July 20, 2008

7. Scoring

- 7.1 Each boat's total score will be the sum of her scores for all races.
 - 7.1.1 There will be no throw-outs for Circles A and B
 - 7.1.2 There will be one throw-out for Circle C if more than seven (7) races are sailed.
 - 7.1.3 This changes RRS 89.3 (a) and Appendix A2.
- 7.2 One race will constitute a series

8. Arbitration

For protests involving the rules of RRS/US Part2, an arbitration hearing will be held prior to the protest hearing.

9. Prizes

- 9.1 Prizes will be awarded to the first, second and third place finishers in each class
- 9.2 There will be an award for best overall performance in the regatta.
