Launch & Fuel Operations

The club launch will be running daily starting Tuesday, September 5th from 0800 hours to Sunset through the end of the season. When calling on the radio (CH 68) repeat "Nor'easter" or "Prudence" at least twice to get our attention, if we do not answer quickly please call again.

Main Dock

Boat Owners please be aware of the boat traffic on the main dock during peak times and weekends. ***During busy times, dock staff will need to enforce the 20 minute rule in order to allow both members and nonmembers opportunity to load/unload, fuel, and use the pumpout. (i.e. Fall Series, Cruise Events, etc.)***

Dumpster Use

All trash is to be disposed of **IN** (not **ON** or **AROUND**) our trash receptacles. If these are full, please go all the way to our main lot and toss it into the big steel dumpster. ***Hazardous materials may not be placed in trash containers and must be disposed of properly.***

Grills

Club grills are available for members to use throughout the fall months. Grills are normally set up for Friday night activities. Otherwise, grill and paper supplies can be obtained by asking the steward on duty.

Internet access is available throughout the club property; password is "bycmember"

Parking

Parking is prohibited in launching areas and other areas restricted by signage. Parking in the loading zone in excess of ½ hour is prohibited. *Overnight parking is allowed only in the South Lot.*
