BECKY CHWALK, CHAIR

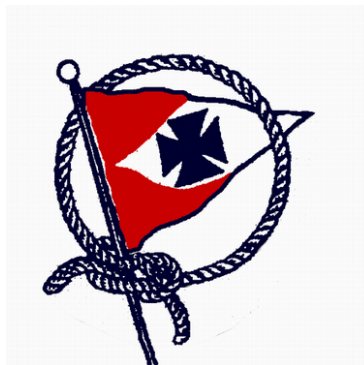
