Notice of Race

June 28, July 5, 12, 19, 26, August 2, 9, and 16, 2017

RULES: The series will be governed by the rules as defined by the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS). Rule A9 applies.

CLASSES: Club 420, Opti, RS Vision and other one design classes (at Race Committee discretion) will be used. Classes may start together unless instructed differently by the RC. The Opti's must meet applicable Class regulations. Club boats used for parent/child(ren) sailing may be used by a qualified skipper at the STP's staff discretion.

REGISTRATION AND ELIGIBILITY: This is a club event and all skippers and crew must be active members of the Club.

FEES: There is an \$8.00 charge per evening for each participating child and/or parent to cover the cost of staff, equipment and food following the races.

SCORING, EXCLUSIONS, AND AWARDS: The Low Point scoring system, Appendix A of the rules, as modified below, will be used for scoring the nightly results. Both the skipper and crew are scored individually and are eligible for awards. There will be no throw outs in the scoring of races for a night of racing. For the purpose of scoring the Series, a sailor must be present for 3 nights of racing to qualify for the Series or the number of nights that are scored less than 3. They must race in at least one race each of such nights racing in the same class boat. If a sailor qualifies for the season, that sailor may exclude the worst individual score for the season. A DSQ may not be excluded. Tie breaking shall be in accordance with rule A8. Awards will be given out each night of racing to the top three sailors in each class.

NOTICES TO COMPETITORS: Notices to competitors will be posted on the official notice board located at the Barrington Yacht Club.

START TIME: The Warning Signal for the first class start sequence will be at 1830.

SAILING INSTRUCTIONS: Sailing instructions will be available at the Skippers meeting, prior to the first night of racing.
