



**Barrington Yacht Club**  
**Ladies Dinghy Cup**  
**Notice of Race**  
**August 5, 2019**

**1. RULES**

- a. The Series shall be governed by the rules as defined by *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.

**2. ELIGIBILITY, REGISTRATION, and FEES**

- a. Participants must be female and the skipper and crew must both be BYC members. Novice skippers and crew are encouraged to participate.
- b. Entry forms and waiver (available on the Club's website) must be returned to the Club by 1600 August 3, 2018.
- c. Registration fee is \$25 per person. Entrants will be billed.

**3. CLASSES**

- a. 420 one-design boats will be used.
- b. Barrington Yacht Club owned boats and sails may be used.

**4. SCHEDULE**

- a. The Night of Racing shall be August 5, 2019.
- b. The first warning will be at approximately 1830, weather permitting.
- c. There will be multiple races (each such race shall be referred to as a "Race") with no set number of races.
- d. There will be a Skippers Meeting at 1730 before racing on August 5, 2019.

**5. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS**

- a. The Sailing Instructions will be posted on the Club's Race Notice Board and available on the Club's web site no less than 48 hours prior to the race.

**6. COURSE AREA**

- a. The course area will be: to the South West of Warren Town Beach; to the West of North Farm; or in Smith's Cove.
- b. The rendezvous point will be in the area to the South West of Warren Town Beach.

## 9. STARTING

- a. The starting system from Appendix S shall be used, modified so that the Warning and Preparatory signals are together at two (2) minutes.

## 7. PENALTY AND PROTEST SYSTEM

- a. The penalty system in rule 44 as modified by Rule T1, will apply
- b. Appendix T, Sections B, and C (rules T-2, T-2 and T-4) will apply.
- c. The protest time limit shall be 30 minutes after the signal boat docks.

## SCORING

- a. Scoring will be in accordance with Appendix A

## Awards

- a. Awards will be given out on the night of racing to top three finishing boats. All participating skippers and crew will receive a regatta t-shirt.

## Miscellaneous

- a. In accordance with rule S-1, all instructions concerning the race, course, safety, recalls, etc. are verbal. Redress shall not be granted concerning this information or the lack or timeliness of same. It is the responsibility of each competitor to remain close to the signal boat when announcements may be made. This changes rule 62.1(a). A competitor receiving this information from the RC does not break rule 41.
- b. LifeJackets are to be worn by all competitors
- c. A social gathering will take place at the club afterwards.
